



Rope Skipping Canada Scholarship 2016



Application Guidelines

Rope Skipping Canada is proud to sponsor an annual Canadian educational scholarship. The scholarship is in the amount of \$1,000. To be eligible, applicants must be active, registered members of Rope Skipping Canada, in good standing, from a province with a director on the board of Rope Skipping Canada, and entering post-secondary education in the upcoming school year. Applicants must be graduating from secondary school in 2015 or 2016 and must be continuing their education, on a full-time basis, at a university or college in September 2016. The successful applicant will be announced at the 2016 Rope Skipping Canada National Championships. A cheque will be issued only after proof of registration at a post-secondary institution is received. The scholarship may only be used for tuition.

Applicants must submit their completed application with ALL required information to the chair of the RSC Scholarship Committee at Scholarship@ropeskippingcanada.com. **Applications are due by 8pm EST on April 7, 2016.** It is the responsibility of the applicant to verify the application was received.

Please note: In evaluating the applications, no weight is given to competition results or rope skipping ability. Please do not include competition results or your personal scores in your application.

The Scholarship Committee is comprised of four provincial representatives. All committee members will evaluate all scholarship applications. The top three finalists will be invited to participate in a 5-10 minute telephone/Skype interview to answer questions pertaining to their applications and contributions to rope skipping in Canada. Interview dates will be communicated to the finalists in mid-April. The committee will make their recommendation of the 2016 award winner to the Rope Skipping Canada board in early May, 2016.

<input type="checkbox"/>	2. Transcripts or a complete record of secondary school grades. The committee requires an official transcript from all applicants who receive an interview. You will be provided with the necessary mailing address upon notification of being selected for an interview.	20%
