

New Club Development Grant

Rope Skipping Alberta has available, a Club Development Grant to help new jump rope clubs become established in the province of Alberta. This grant is to help new clubs with some of the expenses associated with starting a new club. Funds can be used to help purchase club ropes, cover some of the cost of facility rent, advertising and promotion, or other expenses needed to start a new club.

To receive this grant, a new club must fit the following criteria:

- Not be a recognized existing club with Rope Skipping Alberta and/or Rope Skipping Canada.
- 2) Must be in operation for less than one full competitive season.
- The new club must register their members with both Rope Skipping Alberta and Rope Skipping Canada
- 4) The new club cannot be a for profit business/organization.
- 5) New clubs should be a registered Society with the Government of Alberta.
- 6) Provide a Letter of Intention to the Rope Skipping Alberta Board of Directors outlining the clubs plan for the first year which will include a budget (income and expenses), copy of a facility rental contract, and details on how the club will attract and retain members.
- 7) Provide a final report at the end of the season which will include how the grant funds were spent and how the club plans to continue for the next year.

If the club is unable to continue into year 2, any items purchased using grant funds as well as any unused grant monies will be surrendered to Rope Skipping Alberta.

If the club does not provide a final report, the club will be ineligible for any further funding provided by Rope Skipping Alberta.

Funding requests will be accepted until December 31 of the year the club started in.
